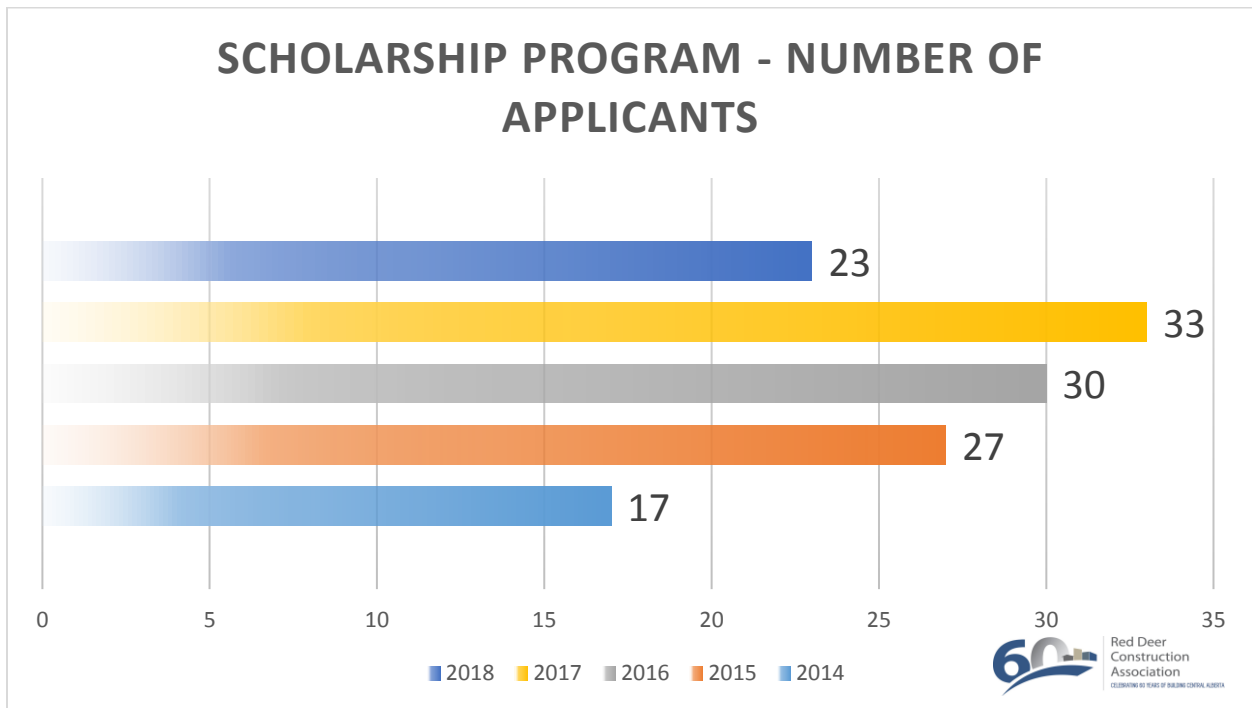
RDCA Scholarship Program

2018

Summary

The Red Deer Construction Association has been honoured for the past 14 years to present scholarship awards to local apprentices. Our association is pleased by the number of applicants and member companies that participate in the program each year, as well as the quality of the applications that continue to mirror the high standards our industry strives towards. The scholarship program is designed to recognize excellence and encourage participants to complete their apprenticeship training programs. The application process opens each year in May and closes in August.

This year we had 23 entries submitted with 22 individuals being awarded scholarships to help towards their ongoing schooling. The scholarship committee of the RDCA awarded three \$1,000 awards, five \$750 awards and fourteen \$500 awards. Since its inception in 2004, the RDCA has awarded a total of 199 scholarships spanning a wide range of various trades totaling over \$109,250. Out of these 22 winners this year, we had representation from 8 different trades (Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Carpentry, Sheet metal, Plumbing & Gas Fitting, Lather-ISM, Roofing, Sprinkler System Installation and Welding), with all attending one of three schools: Red Deer College, NAIT or SAIT.

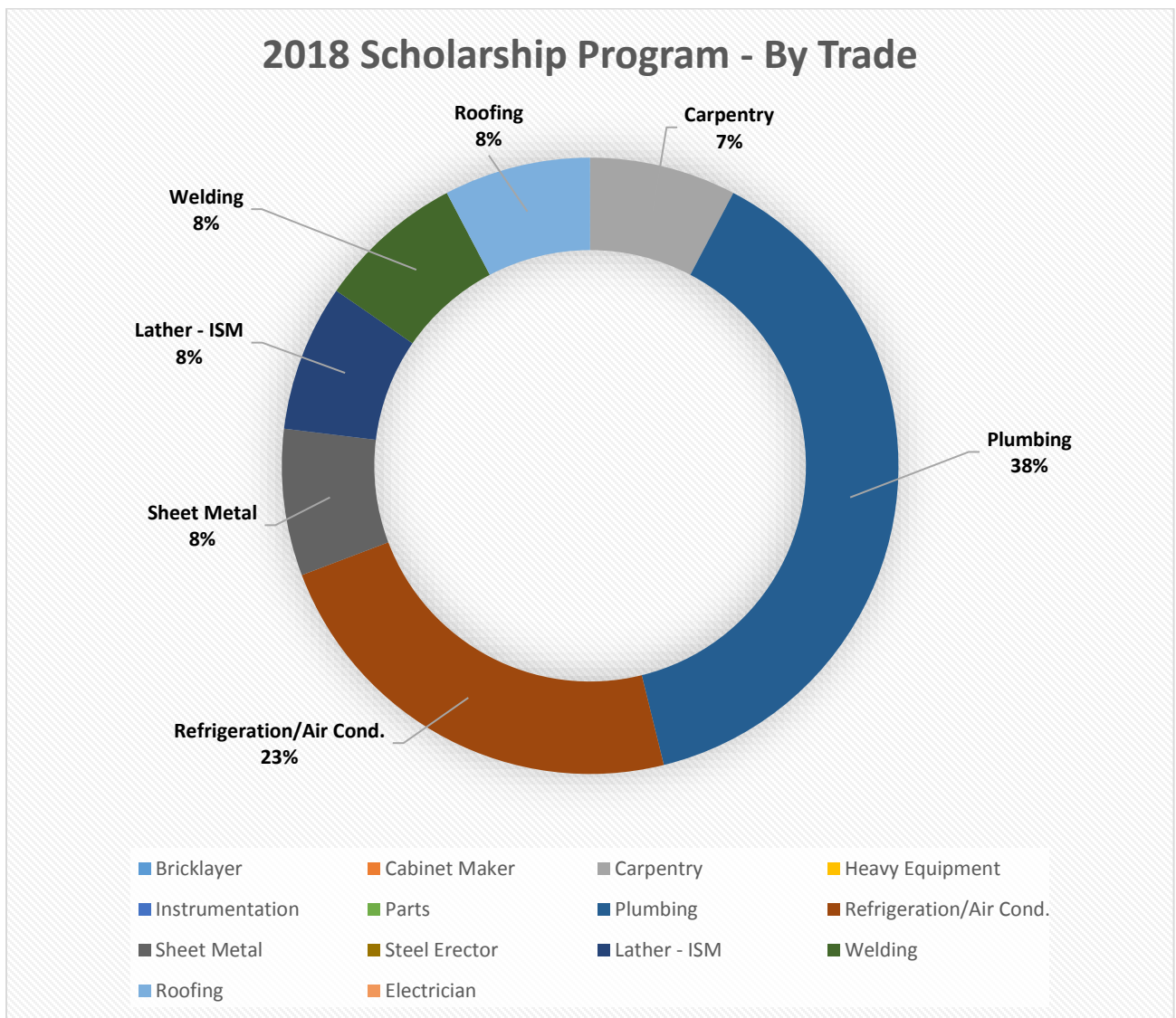

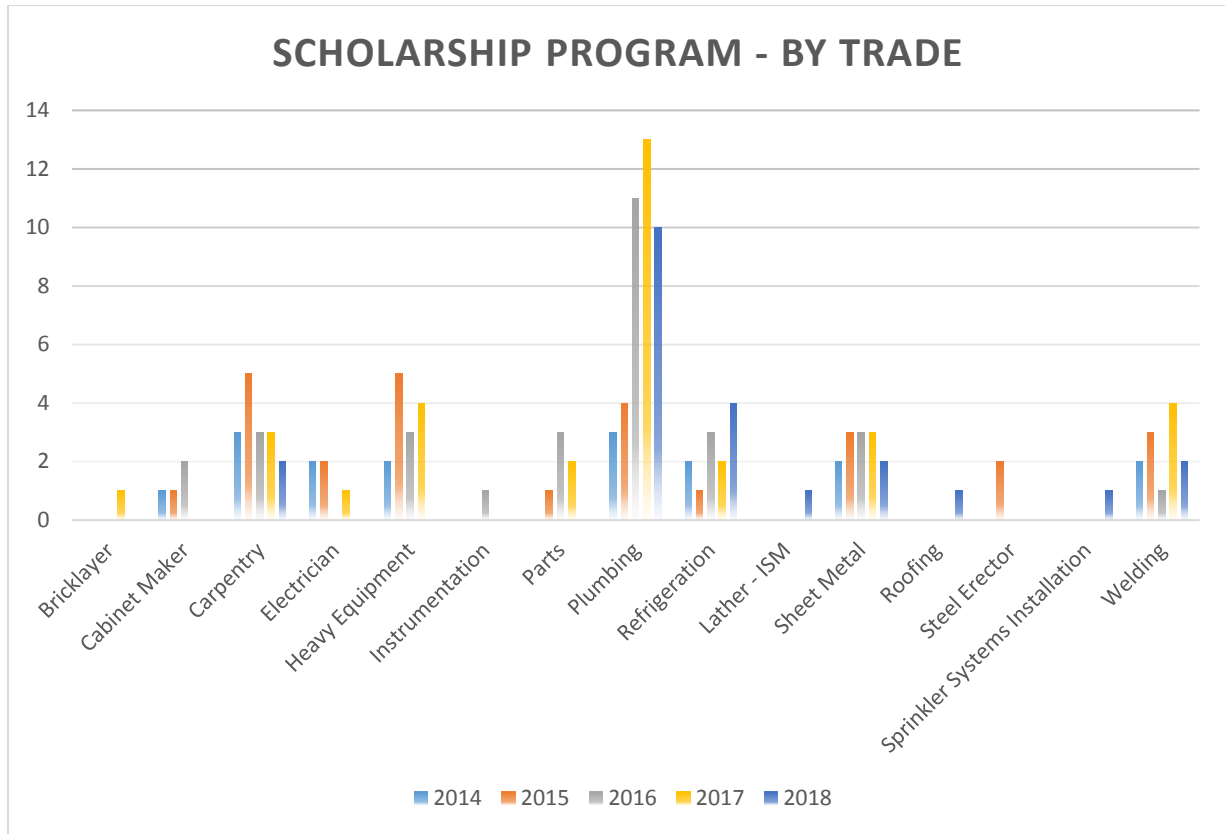

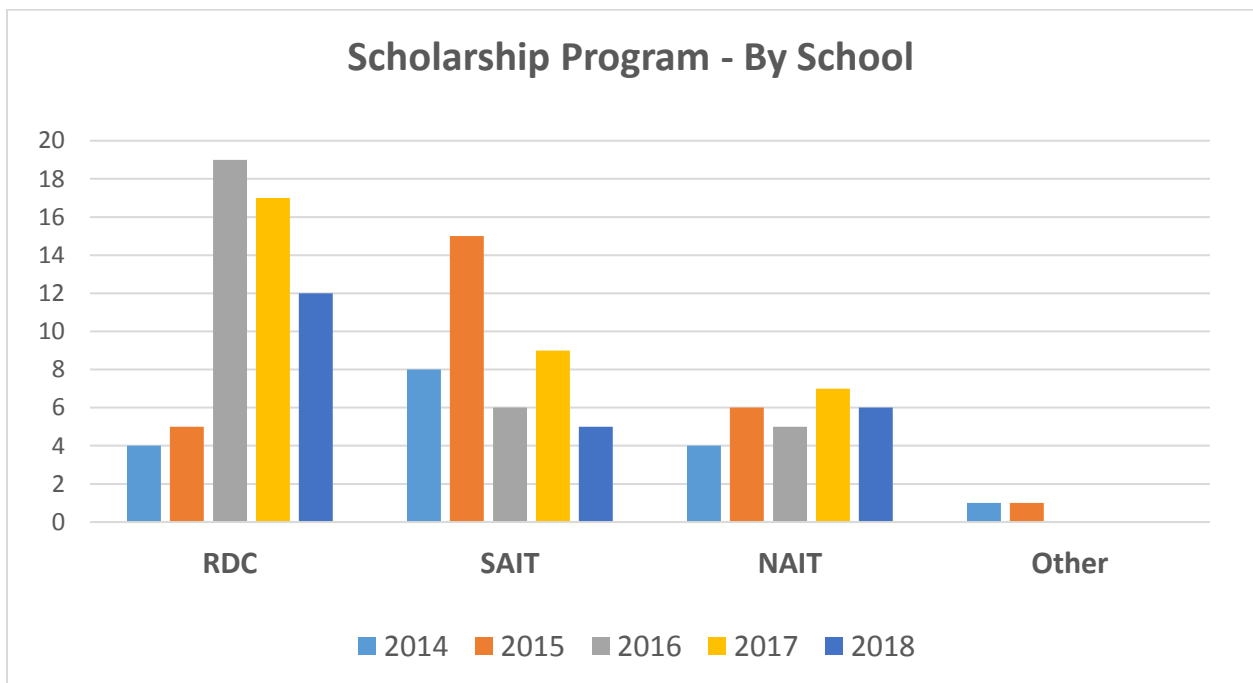
Number of Trades Represented: 8



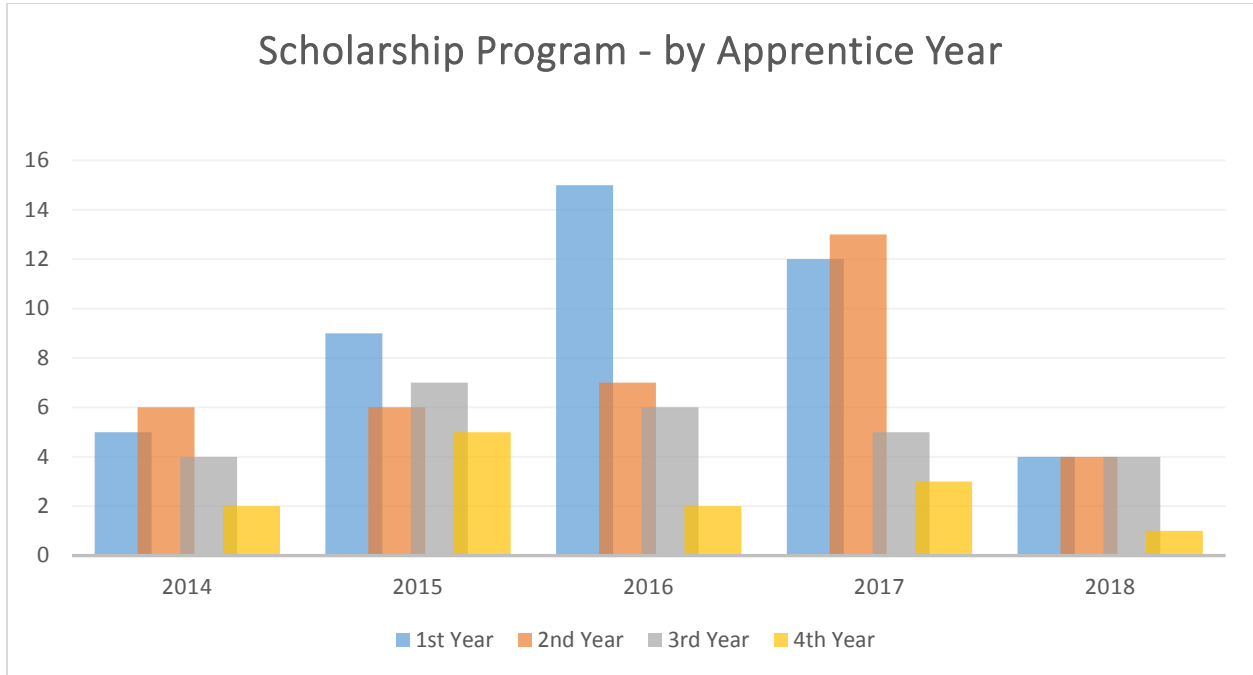
By Trade



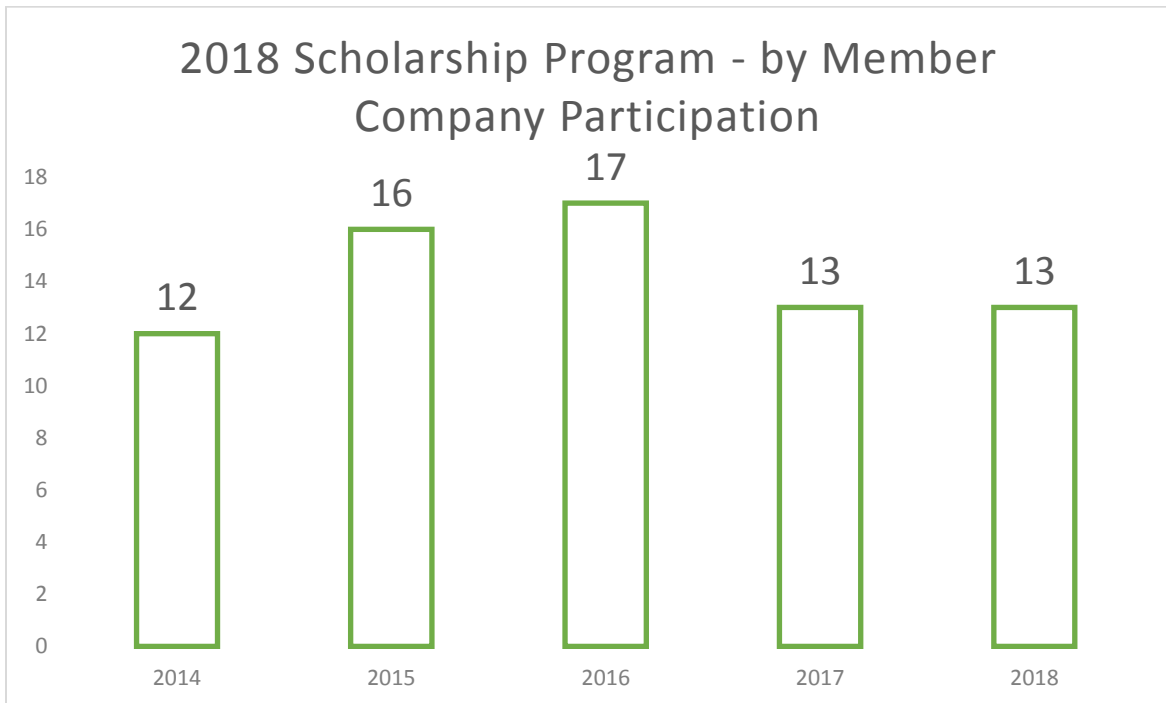
By School
